



The Huber Heights Amateur Radio Club (HHARC) participates in the **American Radio Relay League (ARRL)** 2016 Field Day event on Saturday June 25th and Sunday June 26th.



The event is open to the public and visitors are welcome from 2pm Saturday until 8am on Sunday.

Field Day is Amateur Radio's open house. Showing the public who we are and what assets we bring to our communities helps keep Amateur Radio visible, which is important to the long-term sustainability of our service and hobby.

Setup will start around 9:00 am Saturday morning with operating commencing at 2:00 pm (18:00 UTC) Saturday and lasting until 8:00am (11:59 UTC) Sunday. Talk-in will be on the two HHARC Repeaters 442.950+ PL 118.8 Hz & 224.300- PL 123.0 Hz.

HHARC operates in the 2A category, with two HF radio stations on emergency power at a temporary location. We may have a total of five operating radio stations of one kind or another:

- HF station on Single Sideband (SSB) voice on 40m, 20m, 15m, 10m and 6m;
- HF station split between operating CW (Morse Code) and PSK31/RTTY (keyboard) on 80m, 40m, 20m, 15m and 10m;
- VHF/satellite station and APRS (not counted in category number);
- GOTA (Get On The Air) station (not counted in the category number);



You do not need a radio license to operate our **"Get On The Air (GOTA)"** station. This is a great opportunity to experience amateur radio by doing it. Our control operators guide our guests so that they can make their own radio contacts. Drop-ins are welcome. Those who have held an amateur radio license for less than a year are also eligible to operate the GOTA station.
